

FELONY DRIVING UNDER THE INFLUENCE  
RESULTING IN GREAT BODILY INJURY;  
CHILD ENDANGERMENT;  
DRIVING UNDER SUSPENSION; AND  
HABITUAL TRAFFIC OFFENDER VIOLATION

At a Court of General Sessions, convened on AUGUST 22, 2019 the Grand Jurors of FLORENCE County present upon their oath:

**COUNT ONE- FELONY DUI WITH GREAT BODILY INJURY**

CDR: 0406 56-05-2945(A)(1)

That STEPHEN WAYNE BRITT did in FLORENCE COUNTY, on or about May 8, 2019, drive a motor vehicle while under the influence of alcohol, drugs, or a combination of both, and did an act forbidden by law and/or neglected a duty imposed by law in the driving of the vehicle, to wit: driving a motor vehicle at a speed greater than the posted speed limit and/or failing to maintain his lane of travel, which act or neglect proximately caused great bodily injury to JAYDEN BRITT in violation of Section 56-05-2945(A)(1), S. C. Code of Laws, 1976, as amended.

**COUNT TWO- CHILD ENDANGERMENT**

CDR: 2395 56-05-2947

That STEPHEN WAYNE BRITT, a person eighteen years of age or over, did in FLORENCE COUNTY on or about the May 8, 2019, commit the offense of FELONY DUI RESULTING IN GREAT BODILY while the defendant had one or more passengers under age of 16 years of age in the motor vehicle when the violation occurred, in violation of Section 56-5-2947, S. C. Code of Laws, 1976, as amended.

**COUNT THREE - DRIVING UNDER SUSPENSION**

CDR: 0956 56-01-0460(A)(2)(c)

That STEPHEN WAYNE BRITT did in FLORENCE COUNTY on or about the May 8, 2019, drive a motor vehicle on a public highway of this State while his license or privilege to drive was suspended or revoked pursuant to the provisions of Section 56-5-2990, such not being the first or second such offense within a period of five years including and immediately preceding the foregoing date, in violation of Section 56-01-0460(A)(2)(c), S. C. Code of Laws, 1976, as amended.

**COUNT FOUR- HABITUAL TRAFFIC OFFENDER VIOLATION**

That STEPHEN WAYNE BRITT did in FLORENCE COUNTY on or about the May 8, 2019, drive a motor vehicle on a public highway of this state after having been declared a Habitual Offender by the South Carolina Department of Public Safety, in violation of Section 56-01-1100, S. C. Code of Laws, 1976, as amended.
