**PETITION FOR EXTENSION TO FILE
PETITION FOR WRIT OF CERTIORARI

Counsel had an oral argument in the Court of Appeals in the case of Barrett Bernard Harris v. State on May 9, 2012. In addition, Counsel filed the petitions for writ of certiorari and accompanying appendices in the case of Nicanor Perez Rodriguez v. State and Reginald Davis v. State in this on May 9, 2012. Counsel filed the petitions for writ of certiorari and accompanying appendices in the cases of Demarcus Kentrail Bussey v. State, Sherrod Miller v. State and Albert Romero Lopez v. 


