The Court received your letters dated March 31 and April 1, 2022. If you wish for the Court to take some action, you must file a motion pursuant to Rule 240, SCACR. I call the parties' attention to the Supreme Court's order concerning personal identifying information, which provides in pertinent part "A party seeking to seal material beyond those personal identifiers listed above must file a motion to seal with the appellate court in which the matter is pending. This is true even if the lower court or administrative tribunal may have issued an order sealing the record." *See Re: Revised Order Concerning Personal Identifying Information and Other Sensitive Information in Appellate Court Filings*, 407 S.C. 607, 608 (2014). Please note the appellate courts are not responsible for reviewing filings for redaction or determining if materials should be sealed; that responsibility rests with counsel and the parties. *Id.* At 609.
