



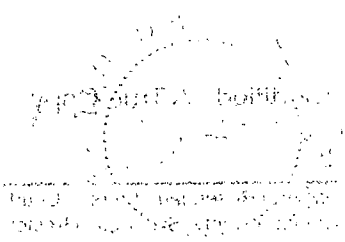

DESCRIPTION OF OFFENSE: Larceny / Petit or Simple Larceny - \$2,000 or less (Enhancement per 16-1-57)

I further state that there is probable cause to believe that the defendant named above did commit the crime set forth and that probable cause is based on the following facts:

On 08/10/2019 at approximately 0815 hours, the defendant, Joseph Cooper, committed the offense of Larceny/Petit or Simple Larceny-\$2,000 or less (Enhancement per 16-1-57) The defendant is observed on video exiting a Silver Volvo Sedan in Chaplin Park at approximately 0808 hours on 08/10/2019 and walking away on foot. The victim's vehicle was parked nearby in the area and the left rear passenger window was broken out and a purse containing items totaling a value of approximately \$327 was stolen. A witness advised she picked up Cooper and he had a woman's purse in his possession. The witness described the purse and some of its contents and this description matched the items stolen from the vehicle. The defendant has numerous convictions for property crimes in ten years prior to this incident, including but not limited to; three B&E Auto charges, three burglary charges, and a petit larceny offense. This incident occurred at 35 Castnet Drive Hilton Head Island, within Beaufort County, SC.
