## ORDER

The Clerk of this Court dismissed the notice of appeal in this matter based on Petitioner's failure to timely file the explanation required by Rule 243(c), SCACR, showing there is an arguable basis for asserting the dismissal of his second post-conviction relief (PCR) application was improper. Petitioner has filed a petition for reinstatement and an explanation pursuant to Rule 243(c), SCACR. The petition for reinstatement is granted. Because Petitioner has not provided a sufficient explanation showing an arguable basis that the dismissal of his PCR application was improper, the notice of appeal is dismissed.
