ORDER

This appeal arises out of a resentencing order pursuant to *Aiken v. Byars*, 410 S.C. 534, 756 S.E.2d 572 (2014). The notice of appeal indicates sentencing occurred on March 3, 2022, and counsel received written notice of entry of the order on appeal on March 8, 2022. The proof of service for the notice of appeal shows service on March 28, 2022. Accordingly, this appeal is dismissed. *See State v. Devore*, 416 S.C. 115, 119, 784 S.E.2d 690, 692 (Ct. App. 2016) ("[I]n the absence of a timely served notice of appeal, this court has no jurisdiction."); Rule 203(b)(2) (stating in appeals from the Court of General Sessions, a notice of appeal shall be served on all respondents after imposition of the sentence or within ten days after receipt of written notice of entry of the order or judgment). The remittitur will be sent as provided by Rule 221(b) of the South Carolina Appellate Court Rules.
