Evidently you did not receive my letter to you dated March 23, 2022, a copy of which was also sent to Devon Puriefoy, or you did not read it. In the Order filed on March 10th, it specifically states, in lines #6 and #7 "..... FOR ALL HEARINGS WHERE A COURT REPORTER WAS PRESENT". In my letter, I specifically pointed out that THERE WERE NO COURT REPORTERS PRESENT FOR ANY OF THE HEARINGS. I also stated that according to the rules established by the South Carolina courts, Zoom hearings on tape COULD NOT be transcribed or used as evidence in that both could be accessed and changed by anyone with access to them, BUT THAT THE COURT COULD ORDER THE TAPES AND COULD LISTEN TO THEM. This is just another example of the mistakes made, not just in Probate Court, but by the Circuit Court in Greenville, including failure to read documented evidence filed with the courts prior to hearings.

This supposed new Order filed on March 28th is just another effort to end or delay this case, and I intend to pursue the investigation of the fraud and mismanagement of my father's estate, not just through the S. Carolina courts, but immediately through other state and federal authorities.

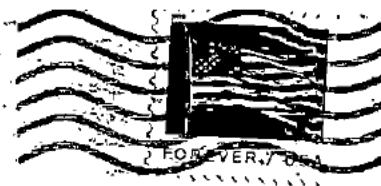
