MOTION FOR AN EXTENSION OF TIME TO
SERVE AND FILE THE INITIAL BRIEF OF APPELLANT
AND DESIGNATION OF MATTER

Counsel for James G. Younger respectfully requests a **fourth and final thirty (30) day extension from April 11, 2022 until May 11, 2022**, in which to serve and file the Initial Brief of Appellant and Designation of Matter in the above-referenced case. This motion is made pursuant to the Order of the South Carolina Supreme Court dated March 18, 2009. This is a fourth request for an extension. In support of this request, counsel shows:

1. The Initial Brief of Appellant and Designation of Matter in this case are due to be served and filed with the Court today.
2. Counsel for James G. Younger respectfully submits that extraordinary circumstances exist which warrant the granting of an additional extension of time. Given the number of extensions previously granted and the order in which counsel attempts to manage his caseload, counsel hopes that no further extension requests will be required.


3. Counsel filed the brief of appellant and designation of matter in the case of The State v. Donald D. Smith with the Court of Appeals on April 8, 2022. Counsel filed the petition for writ of certiorari and accompanying appendix in the case of Panteleimon Spirakis v. The State with the Supreme Court on March 30, 2022. Counsel filed the initial brief of appellant and designation of matter in the case of The State v. Jeremiah Dicapua with the Court of Appeals on March 16, 2022. Counsel filed the brief of appellant in the case of The State v. Jakkari Jaquille De'Andre Brown with the Court of Appeals on March 7, 2022. Counsel filed the brief of petitioner in The State v. Corey Jermaine Brown with the Supreme Court on February 24, 2022. Counsel filed the return to petition for writ of certiorari in Jason Ervin Black v. The State with the Supreme Court on February 23, 2022. Counsel had an oral argument in The State v. Derrick Lamar Porter before the Court of Appeals on February 15, 2022. Counsel had an oral argument in The State v. Sylvester Ferguson III before the Court of Appeals on February 10, 2022. Counsel filed the initial brief of appellant and designation of matter in the case of In the Matter of the Care and Treatment of John Shelby Wells with the Court of Appeals on February 9, 2022.

4. Counsel makes this request in good faith and not for purpose of delay. Counsel intends to continue to work on the cases with more than three extensions first so that the caseload will hopefully become more manageable in the near future, and less extensions will need to be requested.






