MOTION FOR AN EXTENSION TO SERVE AND FILE
THE PETITION FOR WRIT OF CERTIORARI
AND APPENDIX

Counsel for Nathan Lee Teague respectfully requests a **final thirty (30) day extension, from April 15, 2022 until May 16, 2022**, in which to serve and file the Petition for Writ of Certiorari and Appendix in this case. 

Counsel filed the initial brief of appellant and designation of matter in the case of The State v. Nikeen D'Aundre Johnson with the Court of Appeals on March 21, 2022. Counsel filed the initial brief of appellant and designation of matter in the case of The State v. Corey Rashad Brown with the Court of Appeals on March 11, 2022. Counsel filed the petition for writ of certiorari to the Court of Appeals in the case of The State v. Jeffery James Williams with the Supreme Court on March 9, 2022. Counsel filed the initial brief of appellant and designation of matter in the case of The State v. Anterius Braeshun Smith with the Court of Appeals on March 7, 2022.

4. Counsel makes this request in good faith and not for purpose of delay.


