Affidavit of Theodore J. Bolick

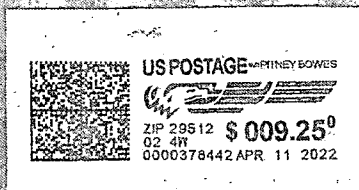
