

ORDER

First, Respondents have filed a motion to strike the record on appeal. The motion is granted to the extent that the record on appeal originally filed is stricken. Within thirty days of the date of this order, Appellant shall serve and file an amended record on appeal that includes all matters designated by both parties and omits any matter not presented to the lower court, including text messages, pictures, and other documents not presented to the Administrative Law Court. All documents included in the record on appeal must be legible.

Second, Appellant's motion to file the record, briefs, and other documents without covers or bindings is granted to the extent that Appellant may provide only one unbound original and no copies for any document filed. The document must still include a cover and all documents must be served on Respondents. In the event this court determines additional copies of certain filings are required, additional copies may be requested.
