Dear Clerk Kitchings:

Rule 207(a) requires that in appeals from the Court of Common Pleas, the transcript must be ordered within ten (10) days after the date of service of the notice of appeal. The date of service upon the Respondent, Elijah Hunter (UPS Tracking #9400111899561930907923) and the Sumter County Court of Common Pleas (CCP) Clerk of Court is 14 October 2021 (UPS Tracking #9400111899561936034159). Thus, the transcript order was required on Monday, 25 October 2021. Below, the Appellant states the following in support of her compliance with this court rule.

1. An initial request for a transcript was made on 16 September 2021 *before* the appeal was docketed with the South Carolina Court of Appeals (SCCOA) on 5 October 2021. This early request was made to aid in providing additional information to the Hon. Ferrell R. Cothran Jr., the presiding judge in the appeal before the CCP (Case No. 2021CP4301534).

3. On 16 September 2021, I requested an expedited copy of the transcript and copied my request to Tammie M. Holmes, Manager of the Court Reporter Manager for the South Carolina Judicial Branch. The hearing was recorded using the Digital Court Reporter Program (DCRP). On the same day, Ms. Holmes confirmed receipt of my transcript request and advised that the court reporter would be in contact with me to discuss the cost of the transcript.
4. On 27 September 2021, Julie A. Cendroski, Circuit Court Reporter III, Seventh Judicial Circuit replied to the transcript request quoting regular costs, but not expedited costs for the transcript. I inquired the same day by e-mail for the correct costs for an expedited transcript. The next day, Ms. Cendroski replied by e-mail with the corrected price and time frame required to complete the work.

5. On 5 October 2021, I filed a Notice of Appeal with the SCCOA with a *Motion and Affidavit to Proceed Without Prepayment of Fees and Costs*, (“*in forma pauperis*” IFP) but the case was held in abeyance until the United States District Court for the District of South Carolina (USDC-DSC) remanded the matter to the State Court.
6. I received a second letter from Ms. Cendroski dated “*November 9*” but with an envelope postmarked 13 October 2021, stating she received my request for a transcript on “*1 October 2021*” with an estimated cost of \$150 for approximately 30 pages. However, my transcript request was actually made two weeks prior on 16 September 2021 and answered.
7. On 22 October 2021, the SCCOA notified the parties that the appeal was no longer in abeyance.
8. On 17 November 2021, retired Chief Judge James E. Lockemy, Jr. denied my IFP motion and ordered payment of the filing fee within 15 days of the date of the order.
9. On 20 November 2021, I inquired with Ms. Cendroski by e-mail whether I missed her deadline to request an expedited transcript and send the payment to her based on the date indicated in her last correspondence. She replied that she was not sure what happened with the dates, but that I may still order the transcript at the same rate.
10. On 3 December 2021, I filed an Amended Motion to Proceed in IFP.
11. On 1 February 2022, new Chief Judge H. Bruce Williams denied the said amended motion and ordered the \$250 fee to appeal within 15 days less the appeal would be dismissed.
12. On 16 February 2022, I filed a motion for extension of time to pay the filing fee with the SCCOA for 30 days.
13. On 3 March 2022, the SCCOA granted an extension to pay the notice of appeal filing fee until March 18, 2022.
14. On 18 March 2002, I paid the \$250 filing fee to the SCCOA at the Clerk’s office in Columbia, SC (Receipt No. 95815).
15. At the time of this letter, I asked the Court Reporter Manager to assign another person for transcription and await her reply. Thereafter, I will make satisfactory arrangements to pay the transcript fee and file such with the SCCOA.
