## ORDER

---

This appeal was dismissed on March 22, 2022. No petition for rehearing was filed as of April 13, 2022, and this Court sent down the remittitur on that day. Appellant has now filed a motion requesting that this court recall the remittitur, reinstate the appeal, and grant emergency relief. A remittitur cannot be recalled except upon "a very strong showing . . . that remittitur was sent down through some mistake or inadvertence on the part of this Court or its officer." *State v. Keels*, 39 S.C. 553, 17 S.E. 802 (1893). Appellant has failed to make such a showing. Because Appellant failed to timely file a petition for rehearing with this Court, remittitur was properly sent, and this Court no longer has jurisdiction over the case. Appellant's motion, therefore, is denied in its entirety.
