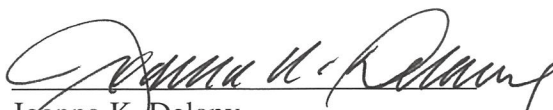

Counsel filed the Petition for Rehearing in the case of Joshua A. Reed v. The State with the Court of Appeals on April 8, 2022. Counsel filed the Anders Brief of Petitioner Pursuant to White v. State in the case of Lorgio D. Morales v. The State with the Court of Appeals on March 29, 2022. Counsel appeared before the Court of Appeals for Oral Arguments in the cases of Devonta Williams v. The State and Georgia Woodberry v. The State on March 15, 2022.

4. Counsel makes this request in good faith and not for purpose of delay.

5. On March 31, 2022, opposing counsel, the Office of the Attorney General, graciously consented to this extension request by way of general consent granted in writing, by Deputy Attorney General Donald J. Zelenka for all Appellate Defense extensions through April 30, 2022

WHEREFORE, the undersigned counsel would respectfully request a thirty (30) day extension until May 25, 2022, in which to serve and file the Petition for Writ of Certiorari and Appendix in this case based upon the above exigent circumstances. Counsel requests that time limits for serving and filing the Petition for Writ of Certiorari and Appendix be held in abeyance pending a ruling on this motion.
