
The trial of this case was held in the Berkeley County Court of Common Pleas the week of April 18, 2022. A jury of citizens from Berkeley County heard this case pursuant to a request for a jury trial filed by the State. Assistant Attorney General Christopher S. Runyan represented the State and James K. Falk, Esquire, represented the Respondent. The jury having heard the presentation of the evidence made the following findings of fact pursuant to S. C. Code Ann. Sections 44-48-90 and 44-48-100:

The State has proven beyond a reasonable doubt that Respondent, Tyrone Maurice Moore, is a sexually violent predator as that term is defined in S. C. Code Ann. Section 44-48-30.

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED THAT:

- (a) Respondent, Tyrone Maurice Moore, is committed to the South Carolina Department of Mental Health for his long-term control, care and treatment;
- (b) Respondent, Tyrone Maurice Moore, is to remain confined at the South Carolina Department of Corrections ("SCDC") until the completion of his criminal sentence, and then transported to the secure facility of the Department of Mental Health. The South Carolina Department of Corrections is to transport Respondent on such scheduled date as is coordinated with the Department of Mental Health.


