

ORDER

Counsel for petitioner has, by way of letter, requested this matter be stayed an additional thirty (30) days in order to allow petitioner and the Eleventh Circuit Solicitor's Office to continue ongoing negotiations regarding petitioner's resentencing, which counsel represents, if successful, would moot this matter. The Solicitor is agreeable to one more thirty (30) day extension of time to resolve this matter with the understanding petitioner will not need or seek additional time beyond May 29, 2013.

We believe an additional thirty days will provide petitioner ample time to complete any negotiations with the solicitor. Accordingly, if negotiations are not successful, the Petition for a Writ of Certiorari and Appendix must be filed with the Court no later than May 29, 2013.
