ORDER

The South Carolina Court of Appeals sent the remittitur in this case on March 23, 2022, after Petitioner failed to serve and file a timely petition for rehearing. Because this Court will only review a final decision of the Court of Appeals and because the remittitur has been sent, this Court will take no action on the petition for a writ of certiorari filed on April 21, 2022, and the petition is stricken and dismissed. *See* Rule 242(c), SCACR (providing a decision of the Court of Appeals is not final for the purposes of review until a petition for rehearing or reinstatement has been acted on); *Stogsdill v. S.C. Dep't of Health & Human Servs.*, 415 S.C. 568, 784 S.E.2d 669 (2016) (stating the sending of the remittitur ends appellate jurisdiction over a case).
