Dear Counsel:

The Court issued an order on March 13, 2022 requiring a notice of appearance to be filed or this Court would presume the Appellant is proceeding pro se. The Court did not receive a response, therefore the Court will consider you to be proceeding pro se.

Upon reviewing your notice of appeal, the following deficiencies have been noted under the South Carolina Appellate Court Rules (SCACR), and each deficiency must be corrected within fifteen (15) days of the date of this letter or your appeal will be dismissed:

- The notice of appeal fails to include a statement of when you received written notice of entry of the order or judgment from which this appeal is taken.
- Your notice of appeal is not correctly formatted. You must submit a notice of appeal which contains the name of the court, judge and county from which the appeal is taken, the docket number of the case in the lower court, the date of the order or judgment, the name of the party taking the appeal, and the names, mailing addresses, and telephone numbers of all attorneys of

record as stated by Rule 203(e) of the South Carolina Appellate Court Rules (SCACR). Your amended notice of appeal shall not contain any arguments.

- You must submit a proof of service pursuant to Rule 262 of the South Carolina Appellate Court Rules showing timely service of the Notice of Appeal on the respondent.
