2. Counsel filed the Anders Brief of Appellant in the case of The State v. Michael Andre Walcott with the Court of Appeals on April 5, 2022. Counsel filed the Final Brief of



Counsel filed the Final Brief of Appellant in the case of James Winston Almond v. The State with the Court of Appeals on March 9, 2022.

3. This request is made in good faith, and not for purposes of delay. Counsel intends to continue to work on the cases with more than three extensions first so that the caseload will hopefully become more manageable in the near future, and less extensions will need to be requested.


