Pursuant to Rule 261 and Rule 263 of the South Carolina Appellate Court Rules, SCACR, Appellant and Respondents jointly request that the Court extend by ten (10) days their deadline to file any petitions for relief in response to the Order issued by this Court on April 29, 2022 in Appellate Case No. 2021-000837.

Appellate Case No. 2021-000837

On April 29, 2022, this Court issued an Order certifying this appeal from the Court of Appeals and simultaneously vacating one or more Orders issued by the circuit court and dismissing Appellate Case No. 2022-000837 as moot (the “Vacating Order”). On the same day, this Court issued a separate Order in Appellate Case No. 2021-001022—denying a petition for a writ of certiorari (“Order Denying Writ”).

On the same day both orders were issued, the Clerk sent the parties via email a copy of the Order Denying Writ in Appellate Case No. 2021-001002. However, the parties were not served with the Vacating Order in Appellate Case No. 2021-000837 from the Court by email or mail. The parties ultimately learned of the existence of the Vacating Order by reviewing the online docket.

Rule 221 provides a period of fifteen (15) days after issuance of a final order by this Court to seek rehearing. In addition, Rule 263 permits the Court to expand the time for doing any act under the appellate court rules.

The parties jointly request that this Court grant ten (10) additional days of time beyond the 15 days provided by Rule 263 to file any petitions they deem necessary in response to the Court’s order dated April 29, 2022 in Appellate Case No. 2021-000837.

Applying Rule 221, SCACR, petitions for rehearing are due no later than fifteen (15) days after the filing of the order at issue, making the parties’ current deadline to file a petition for rehearing with respect to the Vacating Order May 16, 2022. The parties jointly

request that they be granted an additional ten (10) days to file any petitions, including petitions for rehearing, in response to this Court's order issued on April 29, 2022 in Appellate Case No. 2021-000837.

With the requested extension, the parties' deadline to file any petition regarding the April 29, 2022 order would be May 26, 2022.

This is the first time the parties have requested an extension of any deadline in this Court, specifically as to Appellate Case No. 000837 or otherwise. On information and belief, since the request is made by all parties, the moving parties are informed and believe the requested extension would not affect any other deadlines or otherwise prejudice any party.
