This motion is made pursuant to the Order of the South Carolina Supreme Court dated March 18, 2009. This is a third request for an extension. In support of this request, counsel shows:

1. The Initial Brief of Appellant and Designation of Matter in this case are due to be served and filed today.
2. Counsel filed the Petition for Rehearing in the case of Richard K. Galloway v. The State with the Court of Appeals on May 5, 2022. Counsel filed the Petition for Rehearing in the case of Eric Emanuel English v. The State with the Court of Appeals on April 21, 2022.

Counsel filed the Brief of Petitioner in the case of Tappia Deangelo Green v. The State with the South Carolina Supreme Court on April 14, 2022. Counsel filed the Petition for Rehearing in the case of Joshua A. Reed v. The State with the Court of Appeals on April 8, 2022. Counsel filed the Anders Brief of Petitioner Pursuant to White v. State in the case of Lorgio D. Morales v. The State with the Court of Appeals on March 29, 2022.

3. This request is made in good faith, and not for purposes of delay. Counsel intends to continue to work on the cases with more than three extensions first so that the caseload will hopefully become more manageable in the near future, and less extensions will need to be requested.




