I hope this letter finds you well. I represent the Appellants in this appeal, and I am writing with the consent of Respondents' attorney, Thomas Rode.

As Attorney Rode and I were preparing final briefs in this matter, it occurred to us that we require guidance with regard to the Record on Appeal. I spoke earlier today with Appeals Specialist Mary-Caitlyn Singleton, who was very helpful; she recommended that I send this letter.

Our question pertains to certain exhibits to various motions which are a part of the Record on Appeal. Those exhibits were e-filed with the circuit court, simultaneously with the motions. Some of those motion exhibits are pages from deposition transcripts, and they are condensed, meaning that the font is smaller than the pica type required by Rule 267(c), SCACR. I have filed the Record on Appeal with the Court, and an example of such an exhibit may be found at page ROA 0184-0187. Again, this is how the original exhibit was filed with the circuit court.

My understanding is that exhibits filed per Rule 210(f), SCACR, are an exception to Rule 267(c)'s rule on font size. However, we want to be certain that is accurate before we finalize our briefs with citations to the Record. Would you kindly let me know?
