
**MOTION FOR EXTENSION OF TIME TO REQUEST TRANSCRIPT**

COMES NOW the defendant, by and through undersigned counsel, and moves the Court to grant a 30-day extension to request the transcript of appellant’s post-conviction relief hearing.

The Notice of Intent to Appeal in this matter was filed on April 12, 2022. Pursuant to Rule 207(a)(1), SCACR, the transcript is to be requested by May 12, 2022.
