



ORDER


This Court issued an opinion in this case on March 9, 2022. The remittitur was sent on March 25, 2022. On April 4, 2022, Appellant filed a petition for rehearing, which this court declined to consider because it had already sent the remittitur. Appellant has now filed a motion to recall the remittitur. After careful consideration, the motion is denied. *See Wise v. S.C. Dep't of Corr.*, 372 S.C. 173, 174, 642 S.E.2d 551, 551 (2007) ("When the remittitur has been properly sent, the appellate court no longer has jurisdiction over the matter and no motion can be heard thereafter. The only exception to this rule is when the remittitur is sent down by mistake, error or inadvertence of the Court." (internal citations omitted)).
