ORDER

Petitioner has filed a motion to file a Supplemental Appendix and a motion to transport a video at issue in this case to the Court for review. The State has filed a motion to file late returns to Petitioner's motions and to the petition for a writ of certiorari. In addition, the State moves to strike portions of Petitioner's petition for a writ of certiorari.

Petitioner's motions to file a Supplemental Appendix and to transport a video to this Court for review are denied. We grant the State's motion to file a late return to Petitioner's motions and considered that return in ruling on the motions.

Because the documents with which Petitioner wished to supplement the Appendix were not considered by the post-conviction relief court or the court of appeals, we grant the State's motion to strike references to those documents in Petitioner's petition for a writ of certiorari. Petitioner shall have fifteen days from the date of this order to serve and file an amended petition for a writ of certiorari deleting any references to the documents he requested to file in a Supplemental Appendix. The State shall serve and file its return to the petition for a writ of certiorari within thirty days after service of the amended petition.
