**PETITION FOR EXTENSION OF TIME TO FILE
PETITION FOR WRIT OF CERTIORARI
AND APPENDIX**

The undersigned counsel respectfully requests a thirty-day extension in which to file the petition for writ of certiorari and appendix in the above-referenced case. In support of this motion, counsel respectfully shows the Court the following exigent circumstances:

1. The petition for writ of certiorari and appendix in this case are due to be served and filed today, having been extended by one prior order of this Court.

Counsel testified during a PCR hearing at the Richland County Courthouse in the case of James Miller v. State on April 1, 2022. Counsel filed the Anders brief of appellant, designation of matter, and record on appeal in the case of State v. Earl Gaddis in the Court of Appeals on March 28, 2022. Counsel had an oral argument in the case of State v. Terriel L. Mack in the Court of Appeals on March 16, 2022.

3. Counsel makes this request in good faith and not for purpose of delay.


