The Appellant Court Granted Appellant an extension to file Amended Record of appeals that included the request for resolutions Respondent (Deficiency) to insure that the Exhibit were in fact in alphabetical order and added 3 exhibits.

The Court Granted on February 23rd, 2022 an extension for 3 days to file the Amended Record as such the correct and complete Record of Appeal has been filed within the Court Order.

The May 5TH, 2022 Dismissal Order states,, "As of the date of the order, Appellant has still failed to serve and file a correct and complete record of appeal. This is not an accurate statement in the order as the Amended Record of Appeal that is correct and accurate has been filed/was filed on February 28th, 2022. Confirmed sent 2/25/22 within the court order.

I am not sure why I have not been able to complete the order given to me on February 23rd,2022 and fulfilled on February 25th, 2022.

I have filed the Record of Appeal 3 times noting each filing is over 600 pages.

5/13/21: Deficiency, unbound copy and two volumes requested (600 plus Pages)

8/09/21: Filed Two unbound copies, bounded copy.

2/25/22: Amended, Respondent requested Exhibits be in alphabetical order and had 4 exhibits missing.

Noted: The 5/13/21 600 page Record of appeal was correct except for 4 missing exhibits and 3 were out of order, minor deficiencies considering I am not a lawyer. Enough to throw out my Appellant case, right before Trial?

Noted, The respondents request for dismissal was due to TIME and their thoughts on delays. There was/is significant evidence that I submitted on lower court that did not make it to the Appellant Court and my attempts to get with the lower court for resolution fell on deaf ears. Noted Court approved Delays to attempt to add this evidence was granted. All extensions were granted by the court.

I ask the court for some leniency, clarification and reverse May 5th, 2022 Order.

1. I requested extension and was granted by the court on February 23rd, 2022; I fulfilled the Extensions and thus filed record of appeal accordingly on 2/25/22.
2. I have filed the Record of Appeal 2/25/22, within Order Granted to me. Why is the court not recognizing their order being fulfilled?
3. The order reads as if there has been no response or effort by myself to comply with the Courts Request and Process. I have filed 3 - 600 page Records of Appeal and there were only 3 deficiencies. Request for 2 volumes, missing exhibits and exhibits not in alphabetical order.

4. As the order States,

“As of the date of the order 5/5/22, Appellant has still failed to serve and file a correct and complete record of appeal. This is inaccurate and possibly the court was unaware of the extension granted to file by 2/26/22. Record of appeals was filed on 2/25/22. I would ask the court to fulfill their commitment that allowed for me to file Record of Appeal before 2/26/22 as such have on 2/25/22. Reverse the May 5th, 2022 Order and allow process to continue to Trial.

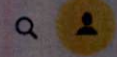

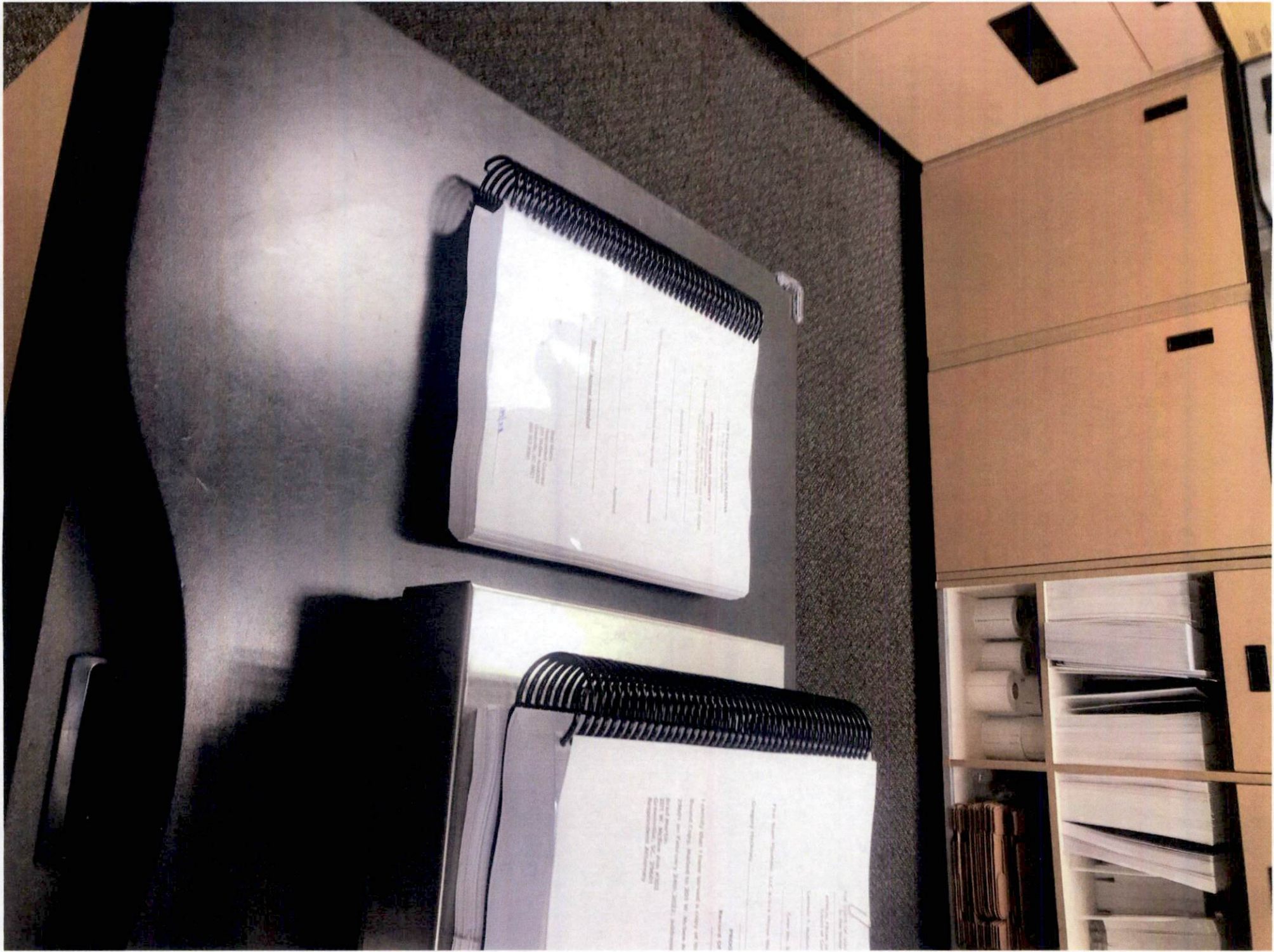

THIS MATTER came before the Court on Plaintiff's Motion for Temporary Restraining Order and/or Preliminary Injunction filed with this Court on September 22, 2017 and Plaintiff's Amended Motion for Temporary Restraining Order and/or Preliminary Injunction filed October 6, 2017. A hearing was held on October 24, 2017. Present at the hearing were John Lyons, as representative for Plaintiff First Team Hyundai ("Plaintiff"), Plaintiff's Counsel, Bradford N. Martin, and Defendant Greg S. Hackney, appearing *pro se*. Having reviewed the pleadings in this matter, relevant case law, and having heard the arguments of the parties, for the following reasons, Plaintiff's Motion is Denied.

BACKGROUND

Plaintiff is engaged in the business of automotive sales and repair and claims a good reputation in the community is crucial to this business. Defendant, by all accounts, a dissatisfied customer, has been appearing daily outside of Plaintiff's place of business and admits to accusing the dealership of lying and committing fraud by way of written signs and oral statements to passers-by. On September 4, 2017, Plaintiff issued a Trespass Notice to the Defendant, at which time the Defendant moved to the right-of-way in the highway adjacent to Plaintiff's business. Plaintiff filed

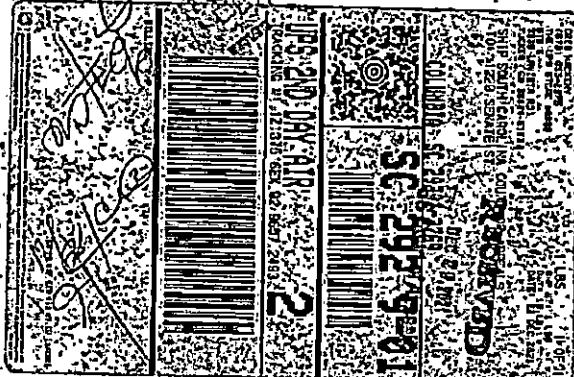
