

Dear Counsel:

The Court received your inquiry regarding deposition transcripts that are smaller than the pica type required by Rule 267 of the South Carolina Appellate Court Rules (SCACR). It is the Court's preference that transcripts be filed in accordance with the SCACR as part of the record on appeal. Exhibits are only acceptable for items that do not lend themselves to accurate reproduction in the record on appeal, as set forth in Rule 210(f), SCACR. Because a transcript can be reproduced in a size that permits it to be inserted into the record on appeal, we would not accept a deposition transcript in a font size smaller than that of pica type, as set forth in Rule 267(c), SCACR.
