MOTION FOR AN EXTENSION OF TIME
TO FILE THE PETITION FOR WRIT OF CERTIORARI
AND APPENDIX

Counsel for Jeroid J. Price respectfully requests an extension of thirty (30) days until June 24, 2022 in which to serve and file the Petition for Writ of Certiorari and Appendix in this case. This motion is made pursuant to the Order of the South Carolina Supreme Court dated March 18, 2009. This is a second request for an extension. In support of this request, counsel shows:

1. The Petition for Writ of Certiorari and Appendix are due to be served and filed with the Court today.
2. Counsel for Jeroid J. Price respectfully submits that extraordinary circumstances

exist which warrant the granting of an additional extension of time. Given the number of extensions previously granted and the order in which counsel attempts to manage her caseload, counsel hopes that no further extension requests will be required.

Counsel filed the Brief of Petitioner in the case of Tappia Deangelo Green v. The State with the Court of Appeals on April 14, 2022. Counsel filed the Return to the Petition for Rehearing in the case of Joshua A. Reed v. The State on April 6, 2022.

4. Counsel makes this request in good faith and not for purpose of delay.

5. On April 28, 2022, opposing counsel, the Office of the Attorney General, graciously consented to this extension request by way of general consent granted in writing, by Deputy Attorney General Donald J. Zelenka for all Appellate Defense extensions through May 31, 2022.


WHEREFORE, the undersigned counsel would respectfully request a thirty (30) day extension until June 24, 2022, in which to serve and file the Petition for Writ of Certiorari and Appendix in this case based upon the above exigent circumstances. Counsel requests that time limits for serving and filing the Petition for Writ of Certiorari and Appendix be held in abeyance

pending a ruling on this motion.
