MOTION FOR AN EXTENSION OF TIME TO  
SERVE AND FILE THE INITIAL BRIEF OF APPELLANT  
AND DESIGNATION OF MATTER

Counsel for Quatase J. Jenrette respectfully requests a **fourth and final thirty (30) day extension until June 24, 2022**, in which to serve and file the initial brief of appellant and designation of matter in the above-referenced case. This motion is made pursuant to the Order of the South Carolina Supreme Court dated March 18, 2009. This is a fourth request for an extension. In support of this request, counsel shows:

1. The initial brief of appellant and designation of matter in this case are due to be served and filed with the Court today.
2. Counsel for Quatase J. Jenrette respectfully submits that extraordinary circumstances exist which warrant the granting of an additional extension of time. Given the

number of extensions previously granted and the order in which counsel attempts to manage his caseload, counsel hopes that no further extension requests will be required.

3. Counsel filed the petition for rehearing in the case of Sherwin Green v. The State with this Court on May 19, 2022. Counsel filed the petition for writ of certiorari and appendix in the case of Charles Lamb v. The State with the Supreme Court on May 12, 2022. Counsel filed the petition for writ of certiorari and appendix in the case of Sam Bunch v. The State with the Supreme Court on May 6, 2022. Counsel filed the return to petition for rehearing in the case of Larry James Tyler v. The State with this Court on May 2, 2022. Counsel filed the Anders brief of appellant and designation of matter in the case of State v. Michaelis Ramsey with this Court on April 19, 2022. Counsel filed the initial brief of appellant and designation of matter in the case of In the Matter of the Care and Treatment of Jeffrey S. Owens with this Court on April 11, 2022. Counsel filed the reply brief of petitioner in the case of Edward Maurice Dunn, Jr. v. The State with this Court on March 31, 2022.

4. Counsel makes this request in good faith and not for purpose of delay. Counsel intends to continue to work on the cases with more than three extensions first so that the caseload will hopefully become more manageable in the near future, and less extensions will need to be requested.

5. On April 28, 2022, opposing counsel, the Attorney General's Office, graciously consented to this extension request by way of general consent granted in writing, by Deputy Attorney General Donald J. Zelenka for all Appellate Defense extensions through May 31, 2022.


