Counsel for David Crockett Robinson respectfully requests a thirty (30) day extension until June 27, 2022, in which to serve and file the Initial Brief of Appellant and Designation of Matter in this case. This motion is made pursuant to the Order of the South Carolina Supreme Court dated March 18, 2009. This is a third request for an extension. In support of this request, counsel shows:

1. The Initial Brief of Appellant and Designation of Matter in this case are due to be served and filed today.
2. Counsel filed the Petition for Rehearing in the case of Jordan Marie Hodge v. The State with the Court of Appeals on May 26, 2022. Counsel filed the Petition for Rehearing in the case of William Bruce Justice v. The State with the Court of Appeals on May 19, 2022. Counsel


filed the Johnson Petition for Writ of Certiorari in the case of Milciades Alcantara v. The State with the Supreme Court on May 6, 2022. Counsel filed the Return to Motion to Allow the State to Supplement the Record on Appeal in the case of The State v. Phillip Lowery with the Court of Appeals on April 27, 2022. Counsel appeared before the Court of Appeals for Oral Argument in the case of Sidney S. Moorner v. The State (2) on April 13, 2022.

3. This request is made in good faith, and not for purposes of delay. Counsel intends to continue to work on the cases with more than three extensions first so that the caseload will hopefully become more manageable in the near future, and less extensions will need to be requested.




