This matter came before the South Carolina Administrative Law Court (ALC or Court) pursuant to a Request for Contested Case Hearing filed on July 29, 2021, by Petitioner Vision Ventures Investment Group, LLC d/b/a Navy Yard on Main (Petitioner). On December 3, 2021, a hearing was held. On December 21, 2021, this court issued an order granting Petitioner's application subject to certain conditions. On January 20, 2022, St. Stephen's Lutheran Church (Intervenors) filed a Notice of Appeal with the South Carolina Court of Appeals. On April 18, 2022, the Court of Appeals issued an Order dismissing the appeal and remanding the matter to the ALC for approval of the parties' agreement. Subsequently, Petitioner notified the South Carolina Department of Revenue (Respondent) that it is withdrawing its application.¹

THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that this court's order filed on December 21, 2021, is hereby vacated, and this matter is dismissed with prejudice.
