MOTION FOR AN EXTENSION OF TIME TO REQUEST TRANSCRIPT

The appellants respectfully requests that the Appellate Court grant the appellants an extension of time to request the transcript associated with a motion to dismiss. After a hearing on a motion to dismiss was granted, the appellants filed a Rule 59(e) SCRCR motion, which was denied without a hearing. The appellants filed their Notice of Appeal on April 19, 2022. At the time of filing, appellants understood there was no transcript to be ordered, as the last "...written notice of entry of the order or judgment (Rule 203(1), SCACR) was the order denying the motion to reconsider of which there was no hearing. While preparing documents for the Record on Appeal, appellants realized the transcript from the motion to dismiss would be helpful for Record on Appeal.

Appellants reached out to counsel for respondents to determine whether the respondents had any objections to filing this motion. As of the date of this filing, the appellants have been unable to determine whether the respondents object to an extension of time to order the transcript. Because the transcript from the motion to dismiss hearing, which took place before the entry of the order related to the Rule 59(e) SCRPC, will be helpful for the Record on Appeal, the appellants respectfully request an extension of time to order the transcript.
