At a Court of General Sessions, convened on MAY 9, 2019 the Grand Jurors of MARION County present upon their oath:

COUNT ONE- INVOLUNTARY MANSLAUGHTER

CDR: 0218 16-3-60

That **STEPHEN WILLIAM FLOOD** did in Marion County on or about September 18, 2018, unintentionally kill [REDACTED] without malice but while engaged in an unlawful activity not naturally tending to cause death or great bodily injury, or while engaged in a lawful activity with reckless disregard for the safety of others, while driving a van and transporting [REDACTED] into Marion County showed reckless disregard for the safety of others by ignoring a clear and present danger of impassable waters and drove the van into visibly life threatening flood waters resulting in the death of Wendy Newton in violation of Section 16-03-0060, S. C. Code of Laws, 1976, as amended.

COUNT TWO- INVOLUNTARY MANSLAUGHTER

CDR: 0218 16-3-60

That **STEPHEN WILLIAM FLOOD** did in Marion County on or about September 18, 2018, unintentionally kill [REDACTED] without malice but while engaged in an unlawful activity not naturally tending to cause death or great bodily injury, or while engaged in a lawful activity with reckless disregard for the safety of others, while driving a van and transporting [REDACTED] into Marion County showed reckless disregard for the safety of others by ignoring a clear and present danger of impassable waters and drove the van into visibly life threatening flood waters resulting in the death of Nicholette Green, in violation of Section 16-03-0060, S.
