MOTION FOR AN EXTENSION OF TIME
TO FILE THE PETITION FOR WRIT OF CERTIORARI
AND APPENDIX

Counsel for Justin Lamont Bradley respectfully requests an extension of thirty (30) days until July 5, 2022 in which to serve and file the Petition for Writ of Certiorari and Appendix in this case. Counsel appeared before the Court of Appeals for Oral Argument in the case of Sidney S. Moorner v. The State (2) on April 13, 2022.


4. Counsel makes this request in good faith and not for purpose of delay.


