MOTION FOR AN EXTENSION OF TIME TO

AND DESIGNATION OF MATTER

Counsel for Da Juan Rayshard Young respectfully requests a **fourth and final thirty (30) day extension until July 6, 2022**, in which to serve and file the Initial Brief of Appellant and Designation of Matter in the above-referenced case. This motion is made pursuant to the Order of the South Carolina Supreme Court dated March 18, 2009. This is a fourth request for an extension. In support of this request, counsel shows:

1. The Initial Brief of Appellant and Designation of Matter in this case are due to be served and filed with the Court today.

2. Counsel for Da Juan Rayshard Young respectfully submits that extraordinary

circumstances exist which warrant the granting of an additional extension of time. Given the number of extensions previously granted and the order in which counsel attempts to manage her caseload, counsel hopes that no further extension requests will be required.


3. Counsel filed the Initial Brief of Appellant in the case of Michael A. Williams v. The State with the Court of Appeals on May 25, 2022. Counsel filed the Johnson Petition for Writ of Certiorari in the case of Jaysen R. Hodge v. The State with the Supreme Court on May 9, 2022. Counsel filed the Anders Brief of Appellant in the case of The State v. Michael Andre Walcott with the Court of Appeals on April 5, 2022. Counsel filed the Final Brief of Appellant and the Final Reply Brief of Appellant in the case of The State v. Gary M. Wirtz with the Court of Appeals on March 28, 2022. Counsel filed the Johnson Petition for Writ of Certiorari in the case of Bruce M. Richardson v. The State with the South Carolina Supreme Court on March 16, 2022

4. Counsel makes this request in good faith and not for purpose of delay. Counsel intends to continue to work on the cases with more than three extensions first so that the caseload will hopefully become more manageable in the near future, and less extensions will need to be requested.






