

IN RESPONSE TO LETTER FROM THE SOUTH CAROLINA COURT OF APPEALS

First of all Appellant is not an attorney and has no attorney representing him because his motion for appointment of counsel was denied. Appellant has corrected you on this matter once. I cannot find the Rule 267(d), SCACR THAT YOU QUOT ED. Doesn't counsel have to do a certificate of counsel?. I don't know, I am not counsel. Once you said that I requested my girlfriend to be my counsel but I never did and you can't show me anywhere in anything that I have filed that I have. I requested counsel and I am requesting counsel once again because it is quite evident that I cannot handle such complicated issues.
