

Devonte Major with the Court of Appeals. On April 28, 2022, counsel attended a reconstruction hearing in the case of Artrell Hickson v. The State before the circuit court. On April 25, 2022, counsel filed the brief of appellant and designation of matter in The State v. David Hill, Jr. with the Court of Appeals. On April 13, 2022, counsel filed the petition for writ of certiorari to the Court of Appeals in The State v. James Allen Johnson with the Supreme Court.


3. This request is made in good faith, and not for purposes of delay. Counsel intends to continue to work on the cases with more than three extensions first so that the caseload will hopefully become more manageable in the near future, and less extensions will need to be requested.
