MOTION FOR AN EXTENSION TO SERVE AND FILE
THE PETITION FOR WRIT OF CERTIORARI AND APPENDIX

Counsel for Reginald A. Dudley respectfully requests a **final thirty (30) day extension, until July 11, 2022**, in which to serve and file the petition for writ of certiorari and appendix in this case. This motion is made pursuant to the Order of the South Carolina Supreme Court dated March 18, 2009. This is a third request for an extension. In support of this request, counsel shows:

1. The petition for writ of certiorari and appendix are due to be served and filed with the Court today.

2. Counsel for Reginald A. Dudley respectfully submits that extraordinary circumstances exist which warrant the granting of an additional extension of time. Given the number of extensions previously granted and the order in which counsel attempts to manage his caseload, counsel hopes that no further extension requests will be required.

3. Counsel filed the petition for writ of certiorari and appendix in the case of Douglas Wright v. The State with this Court on June 7, 2022. Counsel filed the Anders brief of appellant

and designation of matter in the case of State v. Quatase J. Jenrette with the Court of Appeals on June 6, 2022. Counsel filed the petition for writ of certiorari and appendix in the case of Brenton X. Davis v. The State with this Court on June 2, 2022. Counsel filed the petition for rehearing in the case of State v. Sherwin Green with the Court of Appeals on May 19, 2022. Counsel filed the petition for writ of certiorari and appendix in the case of Charles Lamb v. The State with this Court on May 12, 2022. Counsel filed the petition for writ of certiorari and appendix in the case of Sam Bunch v. The State with this Court on May 6, 2022. Counsel filed the return to petition for rehearing in the case of Larry James Tyler v. The State with the Court of Appeals on May 2, 2022.

4. Counsel makes this request in good faith and not for purpose of delay.


